

DOGS and other pets must be under control and on a leash no longer than 6' **at all times**. They are prohibited on all trails/backcountry except in designated areas. They must be kept inside tents or vehicles during nighttime hours. You must pick up after your pet.

JUVENILES will not be allowed to camp without a parent or legal guardian. You must be 18 years of age or older to camp unless accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. If you are under 21 years of age, you may not possess alcoholic beverages.

ARTICLES such as hammocks, clothes lines, and tarps are not to be tied to or hung from trees.

REFUSE, including garbage, cigarettes, paper, boxes, and bottles must be placed only in designated receptacles. There are recycle bins for aluminum, plastic and glass. Please clean up after yourself so that others may enjoy the beauty of this park.

BEARS have not been sighted within the campground. Help to not habituate them by storing food, personal care products, and disposing of garbage properly.

DRONES are not allowed at Sugarloaf Ridge State Park, as per order of the Bay Area District Superintendent.

CAMPING RESERVATIONS: The reservation period is year-round. First-come, first-serve sites can be held the day of arrival with a credit card over the phone starting at 10:00 am.
